AGED CARE FEES EXPLAINED

Aged Care fees can be a combination of the following table. Please note any government contribution towards the cost of your care, services and accommodation is subject to your individual financial circumstances.

- Basic Daily Fee:** an amount that everyone pays and is used to contribute towards your day-to-day living costs and services such as meals, cleaning, electricity, and laundry.
- Accommodation Fee:** these fees vary by Aged Care Facility and room type. Please find more detail as well as payment options.
- Hotelling Supplement Contribution (HSC):** is means-tested with a maximum daily fee capped at \$22.15. Residents who can afford to pay their full accommodation costs will contribute to their day-to-day living costs such as meals, cleaning, laundry, and utilities.
- Non-Clinical Care Contribution (NCCC)** is a contribution towards non-clinical care costs such as bathing, mobility assistance and lifestyle activities. It will only apply to residents who can afford to pay the full Hotelling Supplement Contribution, It will only apply to residents who can afford to pay the full Hotelling Supplement Contribution, and is means-tested with a daily cap of up to \$107.32. The NCCC will also have a lifetime cap where it will no longer be payable when the resident has been in aged care for more than four years; or the resident has paid \$137,917.01 (indexed) in total NCCC's.

ACCOMMODATION PAYMENT OPTIONS

There are three payment options available to fit your budget and circumstances:

- **1. Refundable Accommodation Deposit (RAD):**
 - A one-off lump sum deposit, 100% guaranteed by the Federal Government.
 - Retention amounts apply to all lump sum RAD/RAC*'s paid, calculated daily and deducted monthly at the rate of 2% per annum, and capped at a maximum of 5 years.
- **2. Daily Accommodation Payment (DAP):**
 - Non-refundable, rental style, daily accommodation payment.
 - Indexed twice a year (20 March and 20 September) with the change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- **3. Combination RAD/DAP:**
 - a combination of a RAD and DAP payment.
 - RAD retention & DAP indexation also apply to combination payments.

**RAC – Refundable Accommodation Contribution may apply to some low means residents who are eligible for government assistance towards their accommodation costs based on the outcome of the means-test.*

ACCOMMODATION FEE

Our **Premium Studio Accommodation** (30sqm) is remarkably spacious single studios, designed with modern décor and fittings, and feature a private ensuite with a walk-in shower and modern vanity.
